General information

Milk Crate Theatre welcomes volunteers! As a volunteer you become part of Australia's leading homeless and disadvantaged person's theatre company. A unique community of creative individuals, both with and without homes, who come together to make entertaining theatre, whilst exploring issues, opinions and life experiences in the process.

Milk Crate's areas of focus using theatre are:

- community building;
- life skills in expression, teamwork and communication;
- education exchange and peer to peer learning;
- the expression of voices in the community that aren't heard; and
- improving understanding in society of the complexity of issues involved with homelessness and marginalisation.

The work can sometimes be confronting and often heart-warming. No special skills or previous experience are required to become a volunteer. However, it is important that you have a genuine desire to engage, learn and contribute, as you will become a valued part of the community.
